

Subject: Clarification w.r.t implementation of CAT, Chandigarh Bench order dated 03.08.2012 in OA No.338/PB/2012 filed by Shri Balwinder Singh Matharoo and others-reg.

Sir,

Please refer to Board's letter F.No.C-18012/19/2012-Ad.IIB dated 03.08.2017 on the above subject, wherein it was directed to implement CAT Chandigarh Bench order dated 03.08.2012 in OA No.338/PB/2012.

In this context, it is to mention that 39 posts of Inspectors were upgraded to the post of Superintendent in 1996 vide Board's Order F.No. A-11012/01/96-AdIV dated 10.09.1996 and that such posts were subsequently filled up by holding DPC.

In the DPC held on 21.09.1996, 5(Five) officers who had earlier joined this zone on ICT after foregoing their earlier seniority, were though considered for forming consideration zone based on their length of service, could not be considered for promotion based on seniority, although some of their seniors who had lesser length of service were considered for promotion based on seniority.

The said officers moved to the Central Administrative Tribunal (CAT) and the Hon'ble CAT Cuttack Bench vide OA No.646/1997 dated 23.11.1998 had dismissed their petition citing, inter-alia: "Firstly, to the upgraded posts the petitioners have to be promoted and such promotion can be done only in accordance with the Recruitment Rules. The respondents have stated that the post of Superintendent is a selection post which is to be filled up on seniority-cum-fitness basis. The scheme of upgradation does not indicate that while promoting Inspectors who have rendered the requisite number of years of service to
